CONSENT DECREE, ORDER AND FINAL JUDGMENT

To resolve the violations of law as set out in the Complaint filed in the above captioned matter, Plaintiff State of Vermont and Defendant Meredith Sevigny stipulate and agree to the following:

1. Defendant shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations which concern her operation of a registered child care facility.
2. Defendant shall not file, or permit to be filed on her behalf, any false or inaccurate EMP compliance statements with the State of Vermont.

PAYMENT

3. Not later than December 1, 2009, Defendant shall pay the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for the filing of a false Essential Maintenance Practices compliance statement with the State of Vermont in May of 2009. Payment shall be made to the "State of Vermont" and shall be sent to: Robert F. McDougall, Assistant Attorney General, Office of the Attorney General, 109 State Street, Montpelier, Vermont 05609.

OTHER RELIEF

4. In addition to any other penalties which might be appropriate under Vermont law, any future failure by Defendant to comply with the terms of this Consent Decree shall be subject to a liquidated civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and

additional penalties of no less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) per violation of the Consent Decree per day for each day the violation exists.

5. Nothing in this Consent Decree in any way affects Defendant's other obligations under state, local, or federal law.

6. This Consent Decree resolves only the violations of the Consumer Fraud Act set forth in the Complaint and has no effect upon any other State agencies or actions against Defendant which may be taken by a State agency.

STIPULATION

Defendant acknowledges receipt of and voluntarily agrees to the terms of this Consent Decree and waives any formal service of the Complaint, Consent Decree and Decree, Order and Final Judgment.


