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Hi Charity,

Hope all is well. Still hoping you will be willing to resume our interrupted phone conversation at your convenience.

Meanwhile, we are seeking under Vermont's Public Records Law a copy of any and all police videos from the reckless endangerment case against State Troopers Wood and Trocki that are in your possession or your office staff. This would include both originals and copies.

As you know Assistant Attorney General Rose Kennedy offered a video to the court during the arraignment to try to get the proposed simple assault case to the probable cause stage. We also seek that video, if different, or if it is a portion of the full recording.

As you know the law requires the custodian to provide the records "promptly." We hope we can get the records today as we are working on deadline and should be readily available.

(As you probably remember the legislature finally defined promptly a few years ago because of feet-dragging by certain state offices in responding. The bottom line is it means with immediately, with little or no delay.)
