Dear Mr. Porter:

I write in response to your June 9, 2023 email to the Attorney General's Office (AGO), which the AGO has construed as a Public Records Act request. More specifically, you asked "Where on the AG website can I find 'a brief summary of [past] complaints and their resolutions' per [2 V.S.A.] sec. 267a.? Of have there been [*sic*] no previous complaints which were found to have merit? If you have inadvertently not complied with 267a, can you send me all complaints and resolutions for the past five years via email[?]"

During our telephone conversation on July 12, 2023, you clarified that you were seeking only complaints under Chapter 11 of Title 2 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated that the AGO had substantiated, and any documentation related to those substantiated complaints.

The AGO does not possess any records that are responsive to your request as clarified.
