Re: Public Records Request Follow-Up

Dear Haley Chi-Sing,

I write to respond to your Public Records Act request dated August 7, 2023, in which you requested: *Claudia M. Voight's autopsy, found dead in her home in Windman, CT on Feb 20.*

The autopsy report you requested is withheld from disclosure pursuant to:

- 1 V.S.A. § 317(c)(3) - Records which, if made public pursuant to the PRA, would cause the custodian to violate duly adopted standards of ethics or conduct for any profession regulated by the State.
- 1 V.S.A. § 317(c)(5)(A)(i) - Records dealing with the detection and investigation of crime that could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings.
- 1 V.S.A. § 317(c)(5)(A)(ii) - Records dealing with the detection and investigation of crime that would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication.

To the extent you feel information has been withheld in error, you may appeal to the Deputy Attorney General, Robert McDougall.
