The Attorney General's office is currently defending the State of Vermont in Federal District Court against constitutional challenges to 13 VSA 4019a (Firearm transfers; waiting period) and 13 VSA 4021 (Large capacity ammunition feeding devices).

The Vermont Federation of Sportsmen's Clubs (VTFSC) respectfully requests to know the total cost of defending the State against these challenges to date, starting from 7/1/2023, including the cost of time spent by state employees, costs associated with outside legal firms / consultants, costs associated with hired experts; in short, all costs related to this defense to date.

As this case moves forward, it is likely we will update this request so as to understand

additional costs.
