Dear Ms. Stacey

I write in response to your Public Records Act request dated July 3, 2024, in which you request:

“I am requesting under the freedom of information act information in reference to the Christopher and Nicholas Louras case that took place on October 8th 2019 in Rutland, Vermont.

Specifically interview transcripts or audio from any and all individuals interviewed by law enforcement, if available.

I am also requesting autopsy reports and autopsy photos of both Christopher and Nicholas, if available and covered under the freedom of information act law.

I am requesting crime scene photos from the Salisbury location where Nicholas Louras' body was found and any police body camera footage from that scene.

I also request any photos available from the Rutland Walmart scene where Christopher Louras was shot and killed by law enforcement.

Lastly I am requesting any cellular phone communication record that law enforcement had access to and used in the investigation, primarily text messages between Christopher and Nicholas, and any other relevant text conversation with additional individuals”

Pursuant to 1 V.S.A. §318(a)(5)(B), the Attorney General's Office will need to invoke its right to additional time to respond due to the need to search for, collect, and appropriately examine a voluminous amount of separate and distinct records which are demanded in a single request.

We will further respond within ten business days of receipt of your request.
