I write in response to your Public Records Act request received by the Attorney General's Office on September 19, 2024 in which you requested:

- (1) Documents, including but not limited to correspondence, testing, analysis, reports, notes, pertaining to the Johnson Talc Mine (Mine ID #: 43-00078), located in Johnson, Vermont and owned by Eastern Magnesia Talc Company, a subsidiary of Engelhard Minerals and Chemicals Corp., from December 1976 to June 1983; and
- (2) Documents arising from, pertaining to, and/or discussing any VOSHA inspection of the Johnson Talc Mine in Johnson, Vermont, performed with Eastern Magnesia Talc Company employee Raymond Edward Lomas II from December 1976 to June 1983.
