In the Spring of 2017, your office was notified by either Ogletree Deakins or Norton Rose Fulbright, law firms representing Solera Holdings, Inc. and its affiliated companies (hereinafter Solera), that a data security incident had resulted in the release of personal identification information consisting of name, wage, deduction information and social security numbers of its present and former employees. As a result of the data security incident, our law firm filed a lawsuit seeking damages and equitable relief for our client and a class of present and former employees of Solera.
