Gentlepeople:

I am looking for information on notices that data collectors or other entities have sent you about security breaches during the last 12 months. These are the several types of notices under Chapter 62 of title 9, in §2435.

Information about security breaches involving data collectors that swear in writing that they maintain written policies and procedures

- A copy of the form and the manner prescribed by the Attorney General that is used by a data collector or other entity that intends to swear in writing to you that it maintains written policies and procedures to maintain the security of personally identifiable information and respond to a breach in a manner consistent with Vermont law.
- How many data collectors have sworn in writing to you?
- What are the names and locations of these data collectors?
- How many notices have been provided to you by these data collectors or other entities within the past 12 months?
- What are the contents of these notices?
- How many of the notices within the last 12 months have been withheld from consumers because the data collector or other entity did not consent to the release of the notices?

Information about security breaches involving data collectors that do not swear in writing that they maintain written plans and policies

- How many notices have been provided to you by these data collectors or other entities within the past 12 months?
- How many of the notices within the last 12 months have been withheld from consumers because the data collector did not consent to the release of the notices?
- What are the contents of the notices that were released to the public?

Information about delays in notice to consumers at the request of law enforcement

- How many notices to consumers have been delayed by law enforcement within the last 12 months?
- Which notices were delayed?
- How long have those delays been?
- What are the contents of the notices that were delayed?

Information about security breaches with determinations that misuse is not reasonably possible

- How many notices were sent to you by data collectors that a security breach had occurred and that misuse of the personal information is not reasonably possible?
- How many of these notices were designated as trade secrets by the data collector?
- For those notices not designated as trade secrets, what are the contents of the notices?
