We are in receipt of your public records request dated March 8, 2019. Attached, please find material that is responsive to your request. We have redacted information that, “could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy,” “would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication,” and “could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings,” pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 317(c)(5)(A)(i)-(iii). In addition, we have redacted information whose disclosure would cause us to violate duly adopted professional standards pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 317(c)(3). Finally, we have redacted personal information pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 317(c)(7). See, e.g., Trombley v. Bellows Falls Union High School, 160 Vt. 101, 110 (1993).
