To whom it may concern:

Pursuant to Vermont's Public Records Act, 1 V.S.A. 315-320, I hereby request emails between agency officials and Evan Chadwick related to an July 1, 2018 incident involving Jeremie Meli and Burlington police officers on a Main Street sidewalk.

I make this request on behalf of Seven Days newspaper.

If you believe that we are not entitled to these records, please let me know within three business days, as required by Vt. Stat. Ann. tit. 1, § 318(a)(2), and inform us of the specific exemption that you believe applies to each record or portion of a record being withheld. If an otherwise public record has a portion that is exempt from disclosure, we request that you block out the exempt portion and release a copy of the rest of the record together with a notation identifying the specific exemption that you believe applies to the portion withheld.

If any portion of our request is denied, please notify us of the title and name of the person responsible for the denial, and the name of the person to whom an appeal may be made.
