Dear Ms. Del Palacio,

Thank you for your interest in the work of the Vermont Attorney General. You requested information relating to our budget, staffing, and certain cases related to predatory lending and/or debt collection. I advised you that our Public Protection Division, and specifically, our Consumer Protection Unit handles a wide range of matters related to unfair and/or deceptive practices. We do not specifically assign staff to one type of matter over another. Within our Consumer Protection Unit we currently have 7.5 attorneys and 2.5 investigators.

This electronic correspondence confirms that we discussed your request and you agreed to start with information that is already publicly available in satisfaction of the answer to your questions.
