Re: New Drug Introduction Report Pursuant to 18 V.S.A. § 4637

To whom it may concern:

I write on behalf of Indivior Inc. (Indivior) to notify you, pursuant to 18 V.S.A. § 4637(b), regarding the introduction of a new prescription drug with a wholesale acquisition cost that exceeds the threshold set for a specialty drug under the Medicare Part D program:

- PERSERIS (risperidone) extended-release injectable suspension, for subcutaneous use 90mg
- PERSERIS (risperidone) extended-release injectable suspension, for subcutaneous use 120mg

Further, pursuant to 18 V.S.A. § 4637(c), Indivior is providing the following information, which has been limited to that which is otherwise in the public domain or publicly available, as described in 18 V.S.A. § 4637(d):

(1) a description of the marketing and pricing plans used in the launch of the new drug in the United States and internationally;
