Subject: Public records request dated 4/25 - VAPA "State of Vermont"

Dear Mr. Shaddy:

I write in response to your public records request, dated April 25, 2020 and received by our office on April 27, 2020. I checked the Definitions section of the Vermont Administrative Procedures Act, 3 V.S.A. § 801, available here: <https://legislature.vermont.gov/statutes/section/03/025/00801>. As you can see, although 3 V.S.A. § 801(b)(1) defines "Agency" to include "a State board, commission, department, agency, or other entity or officer of State government, other than the Legislature, the courts, the Commander in Chief, and the Military Department, authorized by law to make rules or to determine contested cases," the entity "State of Vermont" is not a defined term in the Vermont Administrative Procedures Act. As such, the Attorney General's Office has no records responsive to your request.

Please let me know if you had something else in mind.
