Re: Vermont Public Records Act requests, dated May 6, 2020 to May 12, 2020

Dear Mr. Shaddy:

I write in response to your pending requests for public records, dated May 6, 2020 to May 12, 2020. During this time, you made a total of nine requests for public records. Of these, all are pending. These requests include:

5/6/20	Records identifying the person or persons responsible for the production and publication of the documents at the web link sent to me by the Vermont Attorney General and stated to possess "historical" facts.
5/6/20	Records of the appointment or election of Joshua Diamond to the Vermont Office of Attorney General.
5/7/20	Records regarding or containing State policy or policies relating to the licensing of Vermont nurses
5/7/20	Records of or regarding the rules promulgated and adopted by the Vermont State Board of Nursing pursuant to the Vermont Administrative Procedure Act, contested case statutes applicable to licensing.
5/7/20	Records regarding the interest or interests of the people of the state of Vermont served or represented by the Vermont Secretary of State, the Vermont Office of Professional Regulation, the Vermont "Office of State Prosecuting Attorneys", and a "State Prosecuting Attorney" or "State prosecuting attorney".
5/8/20	Records of a Vermont administrative agency which fits this description: an eleven-member board created by the legislature whose members are appointed by the governor to administer the laws for this profession in the state of Vermont... mission is public protection.... does this by: ensuring that applicants are qualified for licensure; setting standards for the profession by proposing statutes and adopting administrative rules; and, with the assistance of Office of Professional Regulation staff, investigating complaints of unprofessional conduct, taking disciplinary action against licensees when necessary to protect the public.

5/11/20	Records of a Vermont court case entitled the “Vermont Supreme Court v David Shaddy”, and or any case or dispute between the Vermont Supreme Court and I.
5/12/20	Based upon the Vermont Attorney General’s prior statements regarding “history”, please provide any records concerning the Vermont State Board of Nursing’s licensure of David Shaddy as a registered nurse.
5/12/20	Records of a Vermont governmental entity named “Secretary of State Vermont APA”, which may or may not house an official called a “Judge Belcher”.

For all these requests, the Attorney General’s Office will need to invoke its right to an extension of the deadline, pursuant to the Vermont Public Records Act, 1 V.S.A. § 318(b)(5)(A), to 10 business days. The new deadline for this batch of requests is May 28, 2020.
