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Please describe the records you are requesting and provide as much specificity as possible, including applicable date ranges.

On Monday, May 25, 2020, approximately around noon, myself and my girlfriend were chased off of Barrows road in Northfield, Vermont by Mr. Hatch. We were up looking for the Paine Mountain network of bike trails which I knew had a trailhead somewhere in the area. However, upon reaching the top of Barrows road, and turning around on the public roadway, Mr. Hatch reversed his truck towards me, almost striking me. I then drove away calmly, and he began to violently pursue me and attempt to hit my vehicle, at which point, we contacted the police. The chase that followed, involved Mr. Hatch almost striking my vehicle, and crossing the yellow line on route 64 into oncoming traffic a few times, and went at least 95 miles per hour in the 50 mile per hour zone. As instructed by the 911 operator, we ran the stop sign at the bottom of 64, and drove immediately downtown to the Northfield police station. Upon arriving at the station, Northfield police officer Logan Potskowski spoke with Mr. Hatch, and also with me. Officer Potskowski got me off of the scene quickly, as to prevent the potential spread of COVID-19. However, on the phone later, he explained to me that Mr. Hatch would be charged by the state for the numerous offenses he committed that day. I would appreciate access to Mr. Hatch's charges once they have been processed, if they have not already. Thank you for your time.
