REQUEST FOR PUBLIC RECORDS

Hello,

Pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 316, I request access to and copies of all records of the following:

- a list of all investigations since 1/1/2017 by the Attorney General's office into officer involved shootings, police use-of-force incidents, and other allegations of misconduct by officers, either on-duty or off-duty.
- For each investigation, I would like to know the date it was opened, the officers involved, where the incident occurred, the outcome of the investigation, what was being investigated and how the case was referred to the AGO's office.

If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions outlined in 1 V.S.A. § 317.

If parts of the records are exempt from release, I ask that you redacted the exempt sections and release the rest of the record.

In the event that there are fees, please inform me of the total charges in advance of fulfilling my request.

However, I would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest. The requested documents will be used by Vermont Public Radio and not being made for commercial purposes.

Thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation in this matter. I look forward to receiving your response to this request. Please call me with any questions.
