Dear Mr. Glawe:

I write in response to your request for public records, dated March 1, 2022. You requested all correspondence to or from the Attorney General, Deputy Attorney General, and Chief of Staff concerning “tech companies’ response to the abuse and harassment of officials and their staff over election-related matters, including the 2020 presidential election.”

In this context, you requested that our office search for the following terms:

- Facebook
- Instagram
- YouTube or You Tube
- Twitter
- Harassment
- Abuse
- Election fraud
- Stolen election
- Forensic audit
- Election
- Threat

The timeframe for this request was from June 1, 2021 to the date of the request, March 1, 2022.

The Attorney General’s Office will need to invoke its right to an extension of the deadline, pursuant to the Vermont Public Records Act, 1 V.S.A. § 318(b)(5)(B), to 10 business

days. The new deadline, accounting for the Town Meeting Day holiday on the date your request was received, is March 16, 2022.
