Pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 316, I request access to and copies of all records of the following:

- The resume and cover letter submitted by Molly Gray in her application for assistant attorney general
- The first draft of the portion of the investigative report of the St. Joseph's Orphanage Task Force prepared by Molly Gray
- All emails between Molly Gray and Natasha Sala concerning the St. Joseph's Orphanage Task Force report
- All emails between Molly Gray and John Waszak concerning *State of Vermont v. Garung*
- All email correspondence between T.J. Donovan, Charity Clark, and John Waszak concerning Molly Gray's performance
- All emails sent by Molly Gray to Mike Pieciak and Mark Levine between March 1, 2020 and Dec. 31, 2020

If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions outlined in 1 V.S.A. § 317. If parts of the records are exempt from release, I ask that you redact the exempt sections with a notation identifying the exemption that you believe applies to the portion withheld and release the rest of the record. If any portion of our request is denied, please notify me of the title and name of the person responsible for the denial and the name of the person to whom an appeal may be made.

In the event that there are fees, please inform me of the total charges in advance of fulfilling my request. However, I would also like to request a waiver of all fees, because the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest. The requested documents will be used by Seven Days and not for commercial purposes.
