Thank you for your confirmation of a reasonable extension of time for review, and if responsive records are found, for production.

My hope and expectation is we can complete a review for potentially responsive records within ten (10) business days. However, if we run into unexpected delay, or some other reason (technical (in order to search closed accounts we must put in a "ticket" with our IT service, so oftentimes requests for older electronic records hinge on our ability to get access to all accounts in a timely fashion), manual, or otherwise) why that may be impossible I will contact you again.
