Dear Attorney Weimer:

I write to respond to your request made pursuant to Vermont's Public Records Act, 1 V.S.A §§ 315-320, and dated May 24, 2022. You seek public records and/or reports that relate to the drowning death of Scott Fleurrey on April 28, 2019 on property located at 3378 Elmore Road, Morristown, Vermont. Please see our response below.

The Fleurrey remains an on-going investigation. For these reasons, we believe the requested materials are exempt from public inspection under § 317(c)(1) (records that by law are designated confidential); (2) (records that by law may only be disclosed to specifically designated persons); (3) (records that, if made public would cause the custodian to violate duly adopted standards of ethics or conduct for any profession regulated by the State); and (5)(A)(i) (records dealing with the detection and investigation of crime the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings) and (iii) (could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy).

If you feel records have been withheld in error, you may appeal to Deputy Attorney General Joshua Diamond.
