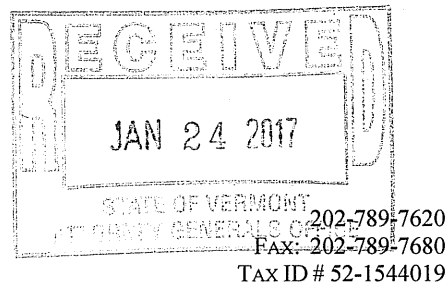

Dear Records Custodian:

I make this request for all records, including but not limited to electronic records, regardless of format, medium or physical characteristic pursuant to Vermont Open Records Law 1 V.S.A. §§315 etseq.

Specifically I request:

- Copies of all communications dating from January 01, 2008 to the present, between – to and from – employees or representatives of the Office of the Attorney General of Vermont and the Federal Trade Commission related to gasoline prices.
- Copies of all communications dating from January 01, 2008 to the present, between – to and from – the Office of the Attorney General of Vermont and all employees or representatives of the Office of U.S. Senator Bernard Sanders related to gasoline prices in the greater Burlington, Vermont area (Chittenden, Grand Isle and Franklin Counties).
- Copies of all consumer complaints sent to the Office of the Attorney General of Vermont's Consumer Protection Unit dating from January 01, 2008 to present related to gasoline prices in the greater Burlington, Vermont area (Chittenden, Grand Isle and Franklin Counties).

In the event that portions of certain records are exempt from disclosure, please provide any reasonably segregable non-exempt portions. Additionally, if the Office of the Attorney General of Vermont believes any records are exempt from disclosure, please provide an index of such records along with a detailed justification specifically identifying the reason each record is withheld. In the event some records are exempt from disclosure, please provide any reasonably segregable non-exempt portions.



To the extent they relate to request detailed in the second and third paragraphs of this letter, our request includes, but is not limited to, paper and electronic documents or reports, daily agendas, calendar information, video and audio recordings, photographs, voice mails, meeting minutes, notes, memoranda, emails, and facsimiles.

The Vermont Open Records Law requires a response to this request within 2 days, or within 10 days for extraordinary circumstances. If you expect a significant delay in fulfilling this request, please contact me with information about when I might expect copies or the ability to inspect the requested records.

If you deny any or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law.
