Thank you for your time and consideration today.

I called your office in an attempt to reach Attorney Prebil, whose public records request is currently under review at our office. Unfortunately, Attorney Prebil was not available. I understand she may return on Monday, February 6, 2017.

Per our conversation, you agreed that narrowing the scope of the request to October, 2013 to present is acceptable. That is my understanding based on our conversation today. If that is not your understanding, or if your firm or Attorney Prebil do not agree please contact me immediately. Thank you for your consideration on that point.

I also inquired if we could narrow the scope of inquiry to the Public Protection Division (which includes the Consumer Protection Unit) and Administrative office because that would also be helpful to production of the records requested. If you are able to reach Attorney Prebil and she is willing to consider and grant that request it would be most welcome. However, in the absence of further clarification on that point we will attempt to locate the records as requested.

We will also generate an estimate of the time and expense associated with Attorney Prebil's request.
