Please process our June 16, 2017, request within the timeframe required under the Vermont Public Records Act.

Additionally, Sarah London says the internal notes of the Deputy Attorney General and the Chief Assistant Attorney General are "likely" exempt.

Thank you for your voicemail this morning, clarifying that you will tell us whether the records are exempt or not so that we can appeal per the Vermont Public Records Act.

I understand Sarah is on vacation this week. I appreciate your willingness to provide us with an answer as soon as possible.
