Dear Mr. Corren:

The Attorney General's Office has gathered documents responsive to your September 17, 2019 Public Records Act request. Responsive documents are now available for your inspection. To inspect the responsive documents, please contact my assistant, Will Sudbay, at 802-371-9798 to arrange a time to come to our office at 109 State Street pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 316(a).

With regards to specific requests:

Request No. 2: This request asks for calendar entries reflecting a meeting between "William Sorrell or Thomas Donovan and any other individuals." We have searched Attorney General Donovan's calendar and gathered any responsive entries. Concerning Attorney General Sorrell's calendar entries, however, the Agency of Digital Services (ADS) destroys calendars of former employees by State policy. Therefore, we were unable to search Attorney General Sorrell's calendar entries.

Request No. 3: This request asks for materials "used directly or indirectly with preparing, executing, or recording any public statements, appearances, and presentations..." Unfortunately, we do not know which, if any, materials were actually used in this manner prior to Attorney General Donovan taking office. However, we have gathered all documents concerning Dean Corren or the 2014 Lieutenant Governor election since May 1, 2014 that appear to be talking points, press releases and related complaints, media advisories, and news articles.

Request No. 4: This request asks for all records provided to or to be provided to Brady Toensing since May 1, 2014 regarding Dean Corren or the 2014 Lieutenant Governor election pursuant to *Brady C. Toensing v. The Attorney General of*

Vermont, No. 2017-090 (2017 VT 99). All such records have been provided to you already and have also been posted to the "Open Government" section of the Attorney General's Office's website.
