Dear Mr. Fleming:

I write in follow-up to my phone call earlier this week concerning your Public Records Act request. As I mentioned, your request is quite broad, touching “any employee of the Vermont Attorney General’s office.” There are roughly 150 employees of the Vermont Attorney General’s Office. If each one of them searched their email, and that took an estimated 5 minutes per employee, it would take an estimated 750 minutes. The first 30 minutes are free, but the remaining 720 would be billed at the Vermont Secretary of State’s Uniform Fee Schedule. The estimate would approach \$400 before we even started reviewing, redacting, or copying any responsive documents.

Please let me know if you are interested in narrowing your search, such as, to a specific division or person. For example, are you looking for consumer complaints against the entities “Bradley Myles” and “Polaris”?

We will wait to hear from you before we move forward.
