Dear Ms. Mangione,

I write with regards to your January 15, 2020 request for records made pursuant to the Vermont Public Records Act. The Attorney General's Office has searched our records for responsive documents. I write with a cost estimate for two options. Let me explain. As a member of our press list, the Bennington Banner receives all media advisories and press releases. If you would just like copies of the media advisories and press releases – but not the e-mail attaching them – it will be less expensive for us to gather them. If you would also like the email, which will clarify the date and time the document was sent, it will be more expensive to gather and redact them. It's totally up to you, but we wanted to be sure you had both options. The two cost estimates are as follows. These cost estimates reflect that the first 30 minutes of time spent is free to the requester.

Option 1 (includes media advisories and press releases only, not the email attaching them): \$5.85  
Option 2 (includes all emails to the press list during the time period requested, including the media advisories and press releases): \$40.05

We will wait to hear from you before taking any further steps.
