Re: Vermont Public Records Act request dated January 10, 2020

Dear Mr. Borden:

I write with a cost estimate for your Vermont Public Records Act (“PRA”) request dated January 10, 2020.

Your request had two parts. The first part of your request was for a log of requests made to the Attorney General’s Office pursuant to the PRA. A log of all requests, responses, and related correspondence can be found on our website, dated from the month Attorney General Donovan took office in January 2017 to the present. That log can be found at the [“Open Government”](https://ago.vermont.gov/) tab of our website, <https://ago.vermont.gov/>.

The second part of your request was for “[a] copy of all of the Attorney General’s calendars for [November 1, 2019 to January 10, 2020].” Under the PRA, the State may request reimbursement for time spent complying with a PRA request over 30 minutes. The estimated time to gather, review, copy, and redact, if necessary, responsive records is 1 hour, with 30 minutes of attorney time and 30 minutes of staff time. Using the Vermont Secretary of State’s Uniform Fee Schedule of \$0.33/minute of staff time and \$0.57/minute of attorney time, your cost estimate is \$13.50 (\$27.00 – \$13.50 for the first 30 minutes = \$13.50).

Please let me know if you are willing to pay the estimated cost of \$13.50. We will wait to hear from you before we take further action.
