I write in response to your request for public records, dated April 7, 2020. You requested: “[A]ny public records regarding the Vermont Attorney General’s prior statutory authority in the form of licensing and jurisdiction to do so over the profession of nursing.”

The AGO does not have records responsive to your request.

As you may know, in 2003, investigative and enforcement authority over professional licensing was transferred from the Attorney General’s Office to the Secretary of State’s Office of Professional Regulation (OPR).
