Re: Vermont Public Records Act request, dated April 16, 2020 (2 of 2)

Dear Mr. Shaddy:

I write in response to the second of the two requests for public records you made on April 16, 2020. You requested: “[A]ny records the Vermont Attorney General has regarding the Vermont ‘Department Secretary of State Professional Licensing.’”

I would appreciate clarity about your request. In Vermont currently, the Secretary of State has an Office of Professional Regulation (“OPR”). Is OPR the office about which you wish to receive records? If so, do the records you seek include correspondence with employees at OPR? Is there a specific timeframe for your request? Please let me know, and we can proceed to put together a cost estimate for you. As a reminder, under Vermont law, requests for public records that are fulfilled within 30 minutes are free to the requester. Beyond 30 minutes, requesters are charged according to the Secretary of State’s [Uniform Charges Schedule](#).
