Dear Mr. Shaddy:

I write in response to your April 15, 2020, appeal of the Vermont Attorney General's Office ("AGO") response to your public records request under the Vermont Public Records Act.

You have appealed the response to the following request: "...public records relied upon by the Vermont Attorney General as the basis for his statement re: prosecution and enforcement authorities added to his public records request response (attached)."

The previous response from the AGO identified publicly available information through the General Assembly's website. In addition, the AGO identified authority under 3 V.S.A. subchapter 3, and the historical summary provided in Paragraphs 12-14 of the decision in *Shaddy v. Office of Professional Regulation*, 2014 VT 111 (Sept. 9, 2014).

I have reviewed your appeal. The AGO has previously provided you with the responsive information.

For the reasons set forth above, your appeal is denied. Under 1 V.S.A. S 319, you may seek judicial review of this determination from the Civil Division of the Vermont Superior Court.
