The Vermont Attorney General claimed, through you and one of the secretaries in his staff, that that was the case. I contacted the State Archives and Records and was informed that the Vermont Attorney General's claim was untrue. I then received an email from the Vermont Attorney General to the State Archives and Records which alleged some confusion.

I responded, and have received no corroborating information from the State Archives and Records, and no public records request response from the Vermont Attorney General.

In the meantime, I have reviewed the online records of the Vermont State Board of Nursing and have found pre-2003 licensing records, by that agency and not the Vermont Attorney General, therein.

Please please have the Vermont Attorney General review his false statements and issue his response to my public records request pursuant to the Vermont PRA, or accept this as my appeal of his denial by refusal, accordingly.
