To whom it may concern:

I am writing on behalf of Tammy Hudson to request records from your agency of all documents relating to any complaints received and any action taken by the agency relating to Tammy Hudson and/or the property located at 5914 Lower Newton Road, Swanton, Vermont.

Pursuant to the Vermont Public Records Act¹, this request includes but is not limited to:

1. Any and all records of the Agency's policies, procedures, regulations, memoranda, guidance, forms, or training related to complaints and actions taken against Tammy Hudson and the above property.
2. Any and all records of complaints received and filed by your agency regarding Tammy Hudson and the above property.
3. Any and all records of actions taken by your agency against Tammy Hudson and the above property.
4. Any and all records of correspondence, emails, notes, e-files related to any of the above categories.

This request includes documents that were created by a member of another governmental agency or a member of the public. If specific portions of any documents are exempt from disclosure, please specify the exemption and provide the non-exempt portions.²

The time frame for the request is January 1, 2013 through the present.

Vermont requires a response to this request "not more than three business days."³ If you expect a significant delay in fulfilling this request, please contact me with information about when I might expect copies or the ability to inspect the requested records.

I request that any records maintained in electronic format be provided in that same format, to avoid copying or duplication costs.⁴ If, however, you are unable to do so, the Farm-to-Consumer Legal Defense


