I write pursuant to Vermont Public Records Law, §315 et seq and respectfully request copies of the following documents:

All Documents submitted by or on behalf of any Insurance Advisory Organization or any casualty/property insurer authorized to sell policies in this state to the Vermont Department of Financial Regulation - Insurance regarding, concerning, relating to, or referencing virus or bacteria exclusions, including, but not limited to, submissions from the years 2005, 2006, and 2007.
2. All Documents regarding, concerning, relating to, or referencing virus or bacteria exclusions, including, but not limited to, memoranda, audits, or reports, whether internal or external, including, but not limited to, Documents from the years 2005, 2006, and 2007.
3. All Documents submitted by or on behalf of any Insurance Advisory Organizations or any casualty/property insurers authorized to sell policies in this state to the Vermont Department of Financial Regulation – Insurance regarding, concerning, relating to, or referencing business interruption claims stemming from the COVID-19 pandemic.
4. All Documents regarding, concerning, relating to, or referencing business interruption claims stemming from the COVID-19 pandemic, including, but not limited to, memoranda, audits, or reports, whether internal or external.

The search for Documents responsive to this FOIA request should include any and all of the Vermont Department of Financial Regulation - Insurance's records dating back to 2002.

As used in this communication, the term “Documents” is used in the broadest possible sense and refers, without limitation, to physical documents, electronically stored information, and other tangible things, including writings, communications, drawings, graphs, charts, photographs, sound recordings, images, and other data or data compilations, stored in any medium from which information can be obtained directly or, if necessary, after translation by the responding party into a reasonably usable form.

As used in this communication, the term “Insurance Advisory Organizations” refers to any entity that, among other services, provides assistance to insurers in ratemaking-related activities. Examples of Insurance Advisory Organizations include the American Association of Insurance Services (“AAIS”) and the Insurance Services Office (“ISO”).

As used in this communication, the term “COVID-19” refers to the disease caused by SARS-CoV-2.
