Dear Justin:

I write in response to your Vermont Public Records Act (“PRA”) request dated June 29, 2020. Your request was for:

[R]ecords of communications, including but not limited to emails, between the [Vermont Attorney General] with employees of Facebook[,] whose email addresses typically end in “@facebook.com” or “@fb.com.” Specifically, [...] communications with Facebook from January 1, 2020 to present related to elections. Possible search terms and keywords for responsive communications include:

- Election interference
- Election meddling
- Foreign election interference
- Election-related misinformation
- Election law violation
- Improper or illegal campaign advertisements
- Removed posts or advertisements from political campaigns
- Censorship of posts
- Consumer complaints regarding election ads, misinformation or offensive posts or censorship of posts.

Please note that if you wish to include text messages within the scope of your request, you must provide either the phone numbers or names of individuals for whom you request the Attorney General search.

The Attorney General will need to invoke his right to an extension of the deadline, pursuant to the Vermont Public Records Act, 1 V.S.A. § 318(b)(5)(A), to 10 business days. The new deadline for this request is July 14, 2020.
