## REQUEST FOR PUBLIC RECORDS

To Charity Clark,

Pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 316, I request access to and copies of all records of the following: the AGO's investigation into use of force by Cpl. Joel Daugeilh of the St. Albans Police Department, including all written reports and video footage of the incident.

If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions outlined in 1 V.S.A. § 317.

If parts of the records are exempt from release, I ask that you redacted the exempt sections and release the rest of the record.

In the event that there are fees, please inform me of the total charges in advance of fulfilling my request.

However, I would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest. The requested documents will be used by Vermont Public Radio and not being made for commercial purposes.
