Re: Vermont Public Records Act request dated July 1, 2020

Dear Liam:

I write in response to your request for public records dated July 1, 2020. You requested:

[A]ccess to and copies of all records of the following: the AGO's investigation into use of force by Cpl. Joel Daug[r]eilh of the St. Albans Police Department, including all written reports and video footage of the incident.

As you know, Mr. Daugreilh has been charged with Simple Assault and the case is ongoing. Therefore, other than the charging documents filed with the Court, the records you seek are exempt from the Vermont Public Records Act pursuant to 1 V.S.A. §§ 317(c)(3) (professional conduct rules) and 317(c)(5)(A) (investigation of a crime). I believe you already have copies of the charging documents, but please let me know if I am mistaken and I would be happy to provide them.
